

NPQG Show Favors - Pin Cushions

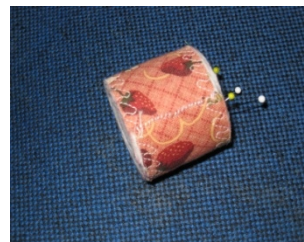
Materials Needed:

Seasonal Scrap Fabric 2" x 6" pieces
Scrap Batting Strips 2" x 24" or 36"

*Note: The length of the batting strip depends on the thickness of the batting. A thinner batting may require a longer length. You will need to play with your batting scraps. The cotton blend battings work best.

Directions:

1. Cut your fabric and batting to the sizes above. Place the fabric scrap on one end of the batting wrapping
 $\frac{1}{2}$ " of fabric around the end.
2. Sew fabric to batting along the edges. Use a decorative or zigzag stitch.
3. Begin to roll up the batting starting on the end without fabric. Roll tightly, but not so tightly that the middle bulges. Roll until you wrap the fabric edge all around the bundle. Put a pin in to hold the end.
4. Hand stitch the edge of the fabric to complete the pin cushion. Remove the pin.



Make as many as you can. Our goal is 1000.
