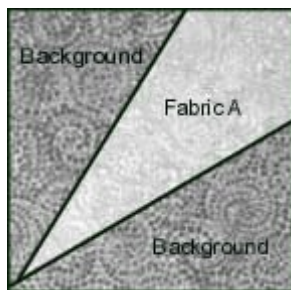
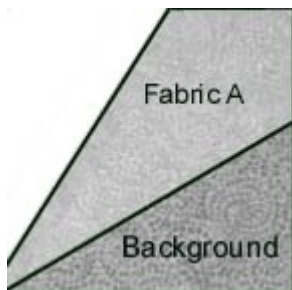


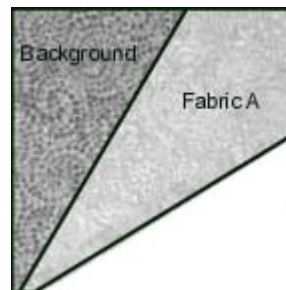
Mystery Quilt Part 4

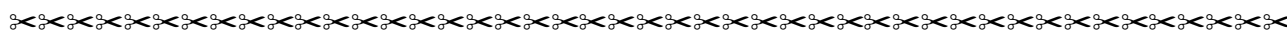

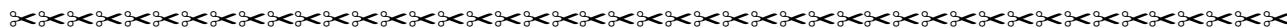
Make 2

For part 4 you will be making 22 full blocks that are 5 1/2" square, and 4 partial blocks (2 different ones) that measure 5 1/2" on two sides.. Again, as in Part 3, there are a couple different ways to make these blocks - your choice of either cutting from templates and sewing, or piecing on paper foundations. Or piece them another way if you have one. Choose your preferred method to follow and ignore the other(s).



Templates

Use your favorite method to make templates from each of the three pattern pieces on Pattern Page #1. The templates are clearly marked for cutting quantities and assembly: Cut 24 each of the two marked for Background Fabric, and 26 of the one marked for Fabric A. Assemble pieces to make 22 full blocks and 2 each of the partial blocks as shown above. Press seam allowances toward the Background Fabric.



Foundation Piecing

Photocopy or trace to make 22 copies of Pattern Page #2 and 2 copies of Pattern Page #3. The foundations are clearly marked to guide you to make 22 full blocks and 2 each of the partial blocks as shown above.

Sew, trim, and remove papers.

Tip: Use the templates on Pattern Page #1 to pre-cut the pieces. Cut about 1/8" larger all around the outside edge of the seam allowance on the templates
