Hi everyone !!! This is the challenge for the 2018 quilt show. The “banners” are arranged by season: Spring, Summer, Fall, and Winter. They measure **6 inches by 48 inches**.

**There are specific colors that will be used for each season.**

**The banner can be ANYTHING that you feel depicts the season.**

The construction can be traditional, modern, applique – whatever your creative mind devises.

We will be discussing this more at the September meeting. We wanted you to have a glimpse and heads-up so that you can decide if you want to participate or not.

We will have space at the show for **32** banners and are hoping to have all **32** spoken for. We will hand out the assignments at the **October** meeting and the finished product will be **due at the April meeting**.

Again, we will have a quilt judging to determine the first, second, and third place winners. This looks like a lot of fun !!!

And, remember the Theme of the 2018 Quilt Show is the **Feathered Star !!**
